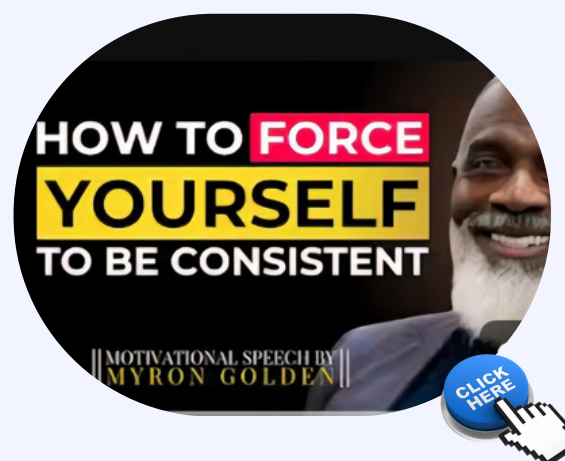

Chidubem is passionate about improving healthcare services in sub-saharan Africa where poor healthcare services and limited educational training has contributed to the loss of many lives including that of her own personal mother Dr Mrs Joy Justin' in 2024.

This passion was ignited after this tragic experience thereby sparking a deep resolve to start an educational program of enlightening student nurses in Nigeria on how to spot the early signs of deterioration in patients.

Chidubem is a qualified Clinical Nurse Specialist trained in the UK. She graduated with a first class in Adult Nursing and has a post-graduate degree (MA) in Clinical Nursing. She is currently working as a Complex Care Practitioner with the NCL ICB.

Advancing Healthcare Standards Through the Joy Justin Memorial Foundation

The Joy Justin Memorial Foundation was established following this personal loss. Turning this tragedy into victory the Foundation was created to drive improvement in patient care and enhance the professional competence of healthcare workers in Nigeria.

To date, the Foundation has successfully organized educational seminars focused on international clinical standards. Additionally, our initiatives include providing malaria treatment, conducting vital signs checks, and distributing healthcare supplies and equipment to underserved communities. These interventions address urgent healthcare needs while fostering long-term systemic improvement.

This personal experience highlighted significant gaps within the healthcare system—gaps that require urgent attention and continuous advocacy.

KEYS TO BIBLICAL WEALTH AND PROSPERITY

Kingdom Principles of Wealth

Wealth is not merely the balance in your account or the gold in your safe, true wealth begins as a mindset. *“As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he”* (Proverbs 23:7).

Dr Myles Munroe taught on 7 Spheres of wealth that all kingdom citizens should strive to attain:

The 7 Spheres of Wealth

1. *Spiritual Wealth*: This refers to one's relationship with God and spiritual growth. Munroe believed that a strong spiritual foundation is crucial for overall well-being and prosperity.

2. *Soulical Wealth*: This encompasses intellectual and emotional development. It's about gaining wisdom, knowledge, and understanding, and developing emotional intelligence.

3. *Physical Wealth*: This refers to one's physical health and well-being. Munroe emphasized the importance of taking care of one's body as a temple.

4. *Social Wealth*: This focuses on the quality of one's relationships with family, friends, and other individuals.

Munroe stressed the importance of positive and supportive relationships.

5. *Influential Wealth*: This sphere centres on one's ability to positively impact the lives of others through their actions and influence. Munroe believed that a good name and reputation are valuable assets in this regard.

6. *Community Wealth*: This involves contributing to the well-being of one's community through service and involvement. Munroe encouraged active participation in making the community a better place.

7. *Generational Wealth*: This refers to creating a legacy that benefits future generations. Munroe emphasized the importance of leaving behind a positive inheritance for one's children and grandchildren, not just financially, but also in terms of values and principles.

Kingdom Principles of Wealth

“For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received [all had a share and we were all supplied with] one grace after another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favour upon favour and gift [heaped] upon gift.” John 1:16 AMPC

“For you are becoming progressively acquainted with and recognizing more strongly and clearly the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ (His kindness, His gracious generosity, His undeserved favour and spiritual blessing), [in] that though He was [so very] rich, yet for your sakes He became [so very] poor, in order that by His poverty you might become enriched (abundantly supplied).” 2 Corinthians 8:9 AMPC

“There are those who [generously] scatter abroad, and yet increase more; there are those who withhold more than is fitting or what is justly due, but it results only in want. [25] The liberal person shall be enriched, and he who waters shall himself be watered. [26] The people curse him who holds back grain [when the public needs it], but a blessing [from God and man] is upon the head of him who sells it.” Proverbs 11:24-26 AMPC

Building a Christ-Centered Home in a Busy World

Family life today often feels like a race, work deadlines, school projects, sports practices, and constant notifications pulling everyone in different directions. In the middle of all this, it's easy for faith to take the backseat. Yet as Christians, our homes are meant to be places where Christ is the foundation. Joshua declared, *"As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord"* (Joshua 24:15).

This is not just a declaration, it's a daily choice. A Christ-centred home doesn't mean perfection; it means creating an atmosphere where Christ, the Word of God, the Blood, the Cross and the Holy Spirit is central and involved in every aspect of family life thereby producing love, grace, and compassion allowing communication and prayer to flow naturally.



Scripture reminds us that *"Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain"* (Psalm 127:1). Every family routine, meals, conversations, even conflict, becomes stronger when God is at the center. Parents are encouraged in Ephesians 6:4 to *"bring [children] up in the training and instruction of the Lord."* Likewise, Proverbs 22:6 promises, *"Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it."*

Welcome to the Kingdom of YAYA

Welcome to the Kingdom of YAYA Here in Ablaze YAYA, we share real and honest truths straight from the hearts of young people, for the strengthening of the whole body of Christ.

This month, our theme is “The Box.” Many of us can relate to this idea. In today’s generation, especially among Gen Z, there are many assumptions and expectations placed on young people, often negative, sometimes positive, but rarely freeing.

From childhood, labels are attached, shaping how society believes we should act, think, and speak. These labels create invisible walls, “the box”, that limit self-expression and make it difficult for many young people to embrace who God created them to be.

When someone gives their life to Christ, God begins the beautiful work of transformation. But breaking free from years of imposed labels is not always easy. Society has written one story, but Scripture reveals another: that we are loved, chosen, valuable, and called to make an impact. Young people today are not weak or without resilience, they are often just misunderstood. The struggles faced by a 16-year-old in the 1980s are not the same struggles faced by a 16-year-old today. Different times bring different challenges, and with them, different ways of overcoming.

Breaking the box starts with listening. When young people are given a safe space to share their hearts on identity, family, faith, relationships, and the world around them, something powerful happens. Expression brings freedom. But before that expression can flourish, there must be understanding, patience, and love from those around them.

Gen Z is a unique generation, in thought, in heart, and in action. When they are understood, they are far more open to correction, guidance, and wisdom. And when they realize that their potential in Christ goes beyond what the world has said, the box begins to shatter. One breakthrough inspires another, until freedom spreads like fire. This is the heart of “The Box”: creating spaces where young people can rise above limiting labels, discover their true identity in Christ, and step boldly into the destiny God has prepared for them.

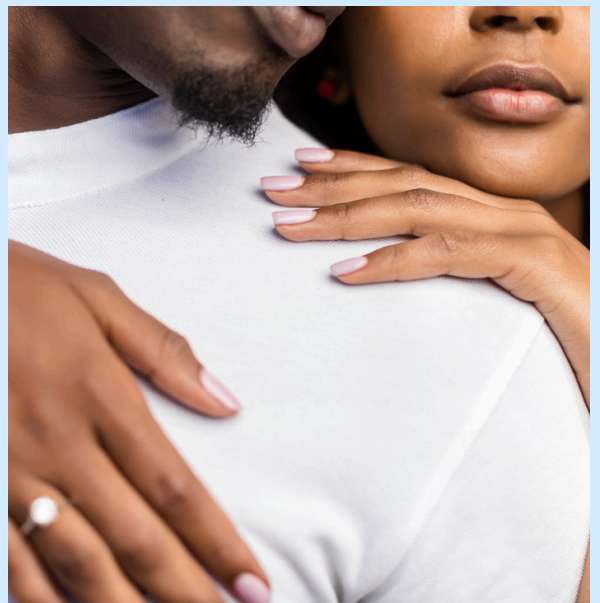
Pillars and Fundamentals for Enduring Relationships

Agape Love 1

I love you is probably the most echoed word in all languages across the world and yet each day we see the world drowning in evil – hatred and bitterness.

The “Me First and Last” culture is taking deeper and deeper root in our personal and national affairs and manifesting itself as conflict, intolerance and all out wars thereby confirming the words of Jesus in scripture that [7] Nation will go to war against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in many parts of the world. [8] But all this is only the first of the birth pains, with more to come. [9] "Then you will be arrested, persecuted, and killed. You will be hated all over the world because you are my followers. [10] And many will turn away from me and betray and hate each other. [12] Sin will be rampant everywhere, and the love of many will grow cold Matthew 24:7-10,12 NLT

[1] ‘You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times. [2] For people will love only themselves and their money. They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God, disobedient to their parents, and ungrateful. They will consider nothing sacred. Pillars and Fundamentals for Enduring Relationships

Nevertheless The word of God enjoins us as Christians to be different Romans 12:2 NLT 'Don't copy the behaviour and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect'. We as Christians not only have the Word of God inscribed on our hearts but possess the Spirit of God and therefore the Love of God – Agape, enabling us to function and relate differently from the people of the world. – Over the next few months we shall be delving into the topic of love and exploring the practical life application principles as written in 1st Corinthians 13.

Agape is a Greek word referring to a selfless, unconditional, and sacrificial form of love, considered the highest type of love within Christianity. It is a love given freely without expectation of return, characterized by kindness, acceptance, patience, and putting the well-being of others before oneself, even in difficult circumstances. In the Christian context, agape represents God's enduring, unwavering love for humanity and the reciprocal love humans are called to show for God and their fellow people.

Key characteristics of agape love:

- **Unconditional:** It is given freely and doesn't depend on the recipient's actions or worthiness.
- **Forgiving and gracious:** it not only forgives and lets go of offence, it issues grace and mercy without pre-conditions or assurances
- **Selfless and Sacrificial:** It involves prioritizing the needs and well-being of others, sometimes even at personal cost.
- **Universal:** It extends to all people, regardless of their relationship to the giver.
- **Enduring:** It persists through difficult circumstances and does not fade or fail.
- **Action-oriented:** It's not just a feeling but is demonstrated through acts of kindness, patience, and grace.



Biblical Agape in Christianity:

- **God's love for humanity:** Agape is the love God demonstrated by sacrificing His son, Jesus Christ, for the atonement of human sin.
- **Human love for others:** Jesus taught His followers to love others unconditionally, even enemies, as exemplified in the Parable of the Good Samaritan.
- **A new commandment:** Jesus' final commandment to His apostles was to love one another, as He had loved them, setting a standard for Christian community.
- **Contrast with other forms of love:** Agape is distinct from eros (sexual or romantic love) and philia (brotherly love), representing a spiritual and profound love that transcends circumstances.

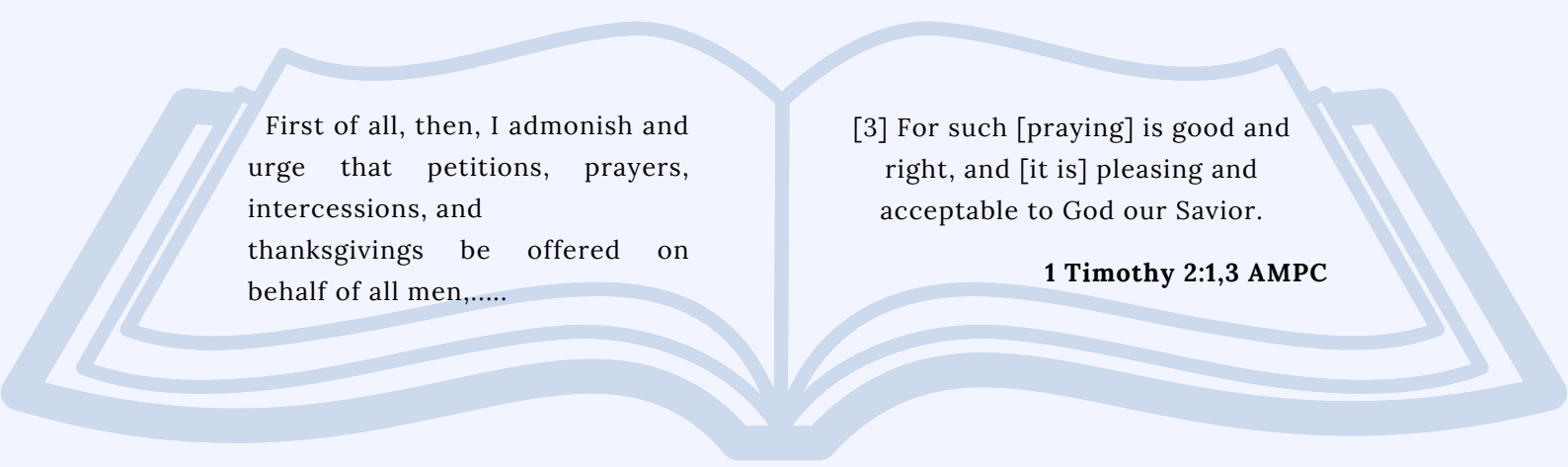
